

education. The tests are marked in Cambridge and provide schools with an external international benchmark for student performance. In Key Stage 4, students begin their 2-year course which prepares them to sit for the Cambridge IGCSE examinations at the end of Year 11. All students follow courses in English Language as a 1st or 2nd Language, Mathematics, Malay as a Foreign Language (compulsory only for Malaysians) and PE. Students then select a range of subjects suited to their individual aspirations and abilities. Senior teachers are often consulted for advice in helping students make the best choices.
