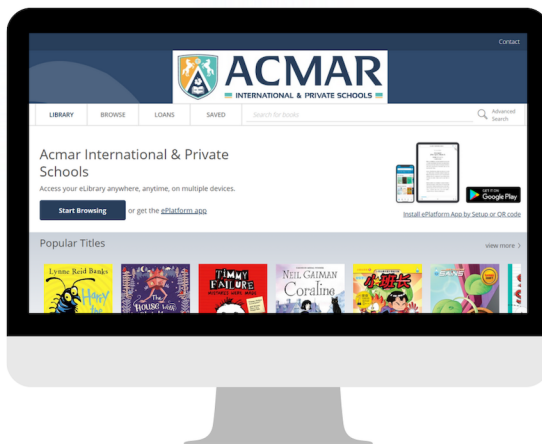


IGCSE Briefing
