## Our Services.

### Early Intervention

Individualized programs catering for learners with speech delay, autism, ADHD, GDD and others with application of **Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Therapy** and **Speech Therapy**. Programs are carefully broken down in our teaching and then bridging to the learner's school life or daily life. Half day and full day sessions available.

### School Readiness Programs

Individualized programs taught in various simulated classroom subjects or settings focusing on classroom behaviors, academic skills, social communication skills in school settings. We assist in systematic transitions back to mainstream schools too.

### Special Needs Daycare & Lunch

Small teacher student ratio of 1:3, parents may work in peace when the learner can receive intervention and daycare services all in one place until the parents pick up after work. Our clinically trained daycare teachers plan activities according to our learners' individual learning needs.

### Diagnosis & Assessments

Our Clinical Psychologist conducts consultation and official diagnosis for individuals displaying signs of different learning conditions and difficulties of any age. Some common diagnoses include diagnosis for autism, ADHD, GDD, IQ Tests, etc.

### Supervision for Schooling Students

We provide consultation and supervision for students with special needs in mainstream schools to ensure the best learning progress of the students in natural school settings.

### Hobby Classes for Special Needs

We offer different hobby classes instructors coming to our centre for classes to ease parents' busy daily routines for transporting the child from one place to another.

### Parents/Teachers Training

We provide customized training and workshops for groups of parents or teachers who are interested to learn more about autism, different teaching techniques or effective solutions pertaining to different speech, behaviour, learning and other concerns.

### Weekend Social Groups

Our Social Group program is a weekly program for students with autism or other learning difficulties to develop social skills. It is intended to be a platform for them to engage in fun and interactive group learning as well as to foster relationships among each learner.
