

INTRODUCTION

Established in 2016, Autism Behavioral Center (ABC) primarily supports individual with Autism, as well as children with learning difficulties and behavioral difficulties, primarily children with ADHD, speech delay and behaviroal challenges. We are proudly the largest Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) center in Malaysia, with over 45 individual therapy rooms (first and on of its kind); this means your child will be able to work 1:1 in their own room with trained therapist.

ABC is supervised by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) and Board Certified Assisstant Behavior Analysts (BCaBA) in accordance to the requirements and high standards of care for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Therapy.

WHAT IS AUTISM?

Autism is a neurodevelopmental disorder that affects:

- · Language and Speech; Children with autism exhibit a delay in speech or no speech development
- Rigid interests or repetitive behaviors; Overinterest in specific topics, and repetitive behaviors such as hand-flapping, spinning, lining inanimate objects
- Socialization; Generally struggles to socialize with peers, or prefers to play alone.

Current statistics of the prevalence of autism is 1 in every 68 children in USA and approximately 9000 children are born a year in Malaysia with autism. There are 3 clinical levels of autism, Level 1 (mild), Level 2 (moderate), Level 3 (severe). Data over 40 years imply and has proven that early identification, early intervention and intensive intervention (30-42 hours a week) improves a childs quality of life drastically, and 50% of children are able to resocialize back into mainstream academia successfully after 2-3 years of intensive intervention. Autism affects more boys than girls. In every 5 children that are diagnosed, 4 are boys.

WHAT CAUSES AUTISM?

There is no evidence we have to date that suggests a specific cause to autism, but current research suggests that genetics and environmental factors play a role

1. Center Based

A trained ABA therapist supporting in school to assist in communication, socialization, emotion regulation, academics, taking and following through instructions and tasks

5. Free Autism Screening & Consultation

A free service provided to help parents or educators identify if their child is at risk of Autism and to provide consultation on early intervention
